- · Health and vigor, uniformity of development, size and weight
- · Apparent sexual maturity in breeding lots
- · Degree of finish and fleshing in market lots
- · Freedom from defects
- · Breed characteristics as to color and size
- · Show condition free of manure, grease, mud and external parasites. Clean and bright.
- Different animals for 4-H and open class.
- · Exhibitors must furnish their own feed. All ages show together.
- Same animal can not be shown in two separate lots.
