- · Apparent sexual maturity in breeding lots
- · Degree of finish and fleshing in market lots
- · Freedom form defects
- · Breed characteristics as to color and size
- Show condition free of manure, grease, mud, and external parasites.
 Clean and bright. All ages show together.
- · Exhibitors must furnish their own feed. All ages show together.

- 9. One Large Fryer 4-51/2 lbs.
- 10. Pen of three Large Fryers 4-51/2 lbs.
- 11. One roaster over 51/2 lbs.
- 12. Two roasters over 51/2 lbs.
