

DIVISION XV RABBITS

Rabbits will be judged by the following standards:

- Health and vigor, uniformity of development, size and weight
- Apparent sexual maturity in breeding lots
- Degree of finish and fleshing in market lots
- Freedom from defects
- Breed characteristics as to color and size
- Show condition – free of manure, grease, mud, and external parasites.
Clean and bright. All ages show together.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own feed. All ages show together.

CLASS A – BREEDING

- Lot
1. Junior Doe *three–five months*
 2. Junior Buck *three–five months*
 3. Intermediate Doe *six–eight months*
 4. Intermediate Buck *six–eight months*
 5. Senior Doe *over eight months*
 6. Senior Buck *over eight months*

CLASS B – MARKET

7. One Small Fryer *2½–4 lbs., up to 65 days*
8. Pen of three Small Fryers *2½–4 lbs., up to 65 days*
9. One Large Fryer *4–5½ lbs.*
10. Pen of three Large Fryers *4–5½ lbs.*
11. One roaster *over 5½ lbs.*
12. Two roasters *over 5½ lbs.*
