## ADAMS COUNTY FAIR GENERAL RULES

- 1. Open to Everyone
- 2. Registration for static entries opens at 12:00 pm Thursday and close at 3:00 pm Thursday.
- 3. Static Exhibits will be released on Saturday at 3:00 pm. Livestock Exhibits must remain on display during the fair until 5:00 pm on Saturday. If an exhibitor or exhibit leaves before that time they will automatically lose any premium money that was awarded.
- 4. Two age divisions will be on display for the static exhibits: Junior Division -18 years of age or younger; Senior Division -19 years and up.
- 5. Absence of competition will not be accepted as justification for awarding a high prize to an exhibit of medium or inferior quality.
- 6. 4 H kids from Adams County will be allowed to show their 4-H small animals entries free of charge in the open class as long as that animal was shown in 4-H. 4-H Sheep, Goats, Swine and Beef entries will pay the entry fee to participate in the Open class Show.
- 7. Include Recipes for all food items. These exhibits must also be covered with glass, plastic wrap, etc.
- 8. If there is more than one type of work on an article, only one type of work will be judged..
- 9. All entries must be clean and presentable to be judged.
- 10. If an article/item was shown previous year's open class it is not eligible to be shown again.
- 11. Premiums will be paid back on the top 2 places in each division. \$15.00 Grand and \$10.00 Reserve in both Junior and Senior Divisions. All other exhibitors will receive a participation ribbon.
- 12. Each livestock class will be announced three times including a "last call."
- 13. One entry per lot for Static Exhibits.
- 14. Exhibitors are Responsible for their exhibits left at the armory after release time.
